school diploma. There is a broad ban on persons who have been sentenced to a felony in the last 10 years. Candidates are also required to pay a filing fee.¹⁴

Candidate registration was generally deemed inclusive by stakeholders and provided voters a genuine choice among a wide range of political alternatives. The number of candidates who competed in the Oct 3 primary election was the highest in the history of the Cheyenne-Arapaho tribes, with 58 candidates contesting. Of these, there were eight competing tickets for the
